ROCKSTAR ENERGY HUSQVARNA FACTORY RACING'S DALTON SHIREY ROUNDS OUT THE TOP TEN AMA BIG 6 GP

Round three of the AMA Big 6 GP series took place this past at Glen Helen Raceway in California and was hosted by the Prairie Dogs MC. Due to the intense downpours throughout the day on Friday, Saturday's course was altered some. It was cold and muddy with track conditions that were rough and rutty, but the dirt was near perfect and the top competitors had average lap times of 12 plus minutes.

Rockstar Energy Husqvarna Factory Racing's Dalton Shirey got off to a good start and sped into the hills in about fourth position. The initial start was tough with roosts that blasted many of the competitions goggles, including Shirey, who went through almost all of his tear-offs. He was riding on pace until a concrete to dirt to concrete section took him down, losing valuable positions. From there he powered through aboard his FX 450 but was unable to catch the lead pack. Shirey would finish tenth in class.

Dalton Shirey: "Conditions were slick in spots and rough in others. One of those spots threw me from my bike, then I couldn't regain spots. I will come back and push to better finishes in the upcoming rounds."
